This day Commences with a fine Breeze from west with clear weather ship heading East by South middle part the same latter part saw 4 sails so ends the day

This day Commences with a fine Breeze from West with clear weather ship heading upon different tack middle latter part the same so ends the day

This day Commences with a strong Breeze from west with cloudy weather with rain ship heading East & East under all sail middle part the same latter part variable winds so ends the day

This day Commences with a fine Breeze from East with clear weather ship heading East under all sail middle and latter part the same so ends the day

This day Commences with a strong Breeze from North with clear weather ship heading East under all sail middle and latter part the same so ends the day

This day Commences with a fine Breeze from East East with clear weather ship heading East saw 1 sail middle and latter part so ends the day

This day Commences with a strong Breeze from East East with clear weather ship heading North under all sail middle and latter part the same so ends the day

This day Commences with fine Breeze from East East with clear weather ship heading North under all sail middle part the same at 11 AM it in Luis Menero died with the Consumption. He was a native of St. Jago aged 22 years so ends this day

This day Commences with light Breeze and clear weather ship heading East under all sail middle part light variable winds at 4 PM saw the Island of St. Mary ship heading different courses so ends the day

This day Commences with light variable winds ship heading different courses at 5 P M Barred Luis Menero at sun down land in sight Baring per compass East distance 40 miles middle latter part the same so ends the day
