Monday Aug 19 1867

This day Commences with light variable winds with clear weather ship heading courses run sail land in sight distant 25 miles middle part the same at 6 A.M. the Captain went on shore at St. Mary's Ship off and on latter part the same so ends this day

Tuesday Aug 20th

This day Commences with a light breeze from the S.W. with clear weather ship off and on at St. Mary's Captain on shore discharged Antonio Rodrick and got 4 other men at 1 P.M. the Captain came on board got some Potatoes and Onions ship heading S.W. this and scaled 100 lbs of Blackfish oil at 8 P.M. Captain on board and kept of south middle and latter part the same so ends the day

This day Commences with a fine Breeze from west with clear weather ship heading south at run down land in sight distant 60 miles middle and latter part the same so ends the day

This day Commences with a light Breeze from west with clear weather ship heading S.W. west run sail middle and latter part the same so ends this day

This day commences with a light variable breeze ship heading on different courses spoke Bark Triton. John Cornell Master of New Bedford 26 months out. 1000 bbl of sp. oil. middle part ship upon diprants tacks latter part heading S.W. by South so ends the day
