

Remarks on Board Bark Mattapoisett

Sunday Sept 15

1867

This day Commences with light variable winds with clear weather ship upon distant tacks at sun down land distant 15 miles center part of the Island Bearing of E middle part the same latter part strong breeze from East so ends the day.

Monday Sept 16

This day Commences with a strong Breeze from East with clear weather ship heading SE at sun down land in sight distant 25 miles middle part the same latter part ship heading S by W so ends the day.

Tuesday Sept 17

This day Commences with a fine Breeze from East with clear weather ship heading SE at sun down all sail middle part the same at day light rain Great Sables at 9 A.M. Pick up 1 Cask of Palm oil so ends the day.

This day Commences with light Breeze from East with clear weather ship heading S by E under all sail middle part the same latter part saw the Island of Teneriffe so ends the day.

Thursday, Sept. 19.

This day commences with light breeze from N. East, with clear weather, ship heading S. W. by S. half S. Island of Teneriffe in sight. Middle part the same. Came to anchor

of Westport Alfred C Davis Master

Thursday 20

1867

This day Commences with a light Breeze from East with clear weather ship heading S by S at sun down land distant 30 miles. Middle part the same. Came to anchor at about 7 A.M. so ends this day.

Friday, Sept. 21

This day commences with light breeze from East. Laying to an anchor off St. Cruz Island of Teneriffe. Middle and latter part the same so ends the day.

Saturday Sept 22

This day Commences with a strong Breeze from East at anchor waiting for orders to land middle and latter part the same so ends the day.

Sunday Sept 23

This day Commences with a fine Breeze East ship at anchor middle part the same at 6 A.M. took our anchor and went to sea latter part employed in stowing the anchor and chains so ends the day.

This day Commences with a fine Breeze from East with clear weather ship upon distant tacks at sun down land in sight distant 20 miles middle and latter part the same but a rain main sail so ends the day.
