This day Commences with a light Breeze from E to East with fine weather ship heading S by East under all sail same sail middle and latter part the same so ends the day

This day Commences with a fine Breeze from E to East with clear weather ship heading S by E. Bet. 10 am main spruce saw 2 sails middle part the same latter part heading East by E so ends the day

This day Commences with a fine Breeze from E to East ship heading S by E. Bet. 10 am saw 2 sails middle and latter part the same so ends the day
