1867

This day Commences with a strong Breeze from N East with smoky weather ship heading S west saw 4 sails middle part the same latter part employed in mowing fore top sail so ends the day

Friday Oct 25

This day Commences with a strong Breeze from N East with smoky weather ship heading S west by South employed in mowing fore top sail middle and latter part the same so ends the day

This day Commences with a strong variable winds with squally with rain ship heading different courses middle part the same latter part fine weather so ends the day

Sunday Oct 27

This day Commences with strong variable winds with clear ship heading S by west saw 1 sail middle part the same latter part saw 4 sails so ends the day

This day Commences with fine Breeze from E to N East with fine weather ship heading S by west under all sail middle and latter part the same so ends the day

Tuesday Oct 29

1867

This day Commences with variable winds with rain ship heading different courses saw 1 sail middle and latter part the same so ends the day

This day Commences with variable winds with rain ship heading different courses saw a number of sails in sight middle and latter part the same so ends the day
