1868

This day commences with a fine Breeze from N East with clear weather Ship heading N West under all sail middle part the same latter part Ship heading N East same sails so ends the day

This day commences with fine weather Ship heading different courses at sun down tack in the light sails middle and latter part light Breeze from N East Ship heading N East under all sail so ends the day

This day commences with fine Breeze from N East with clear weather Ship heading different tacks. One sail in sight. Middle and latter part the same. So ends this day.
