This day commences with a fine Breeze from E East with clear weather ship heading E we saw 2 Whalers middle part the same latter part strong Breeze ends the day

This day commences with a strong Breeze from East with smoky weather ship upon distant tacks saw a number of sails middle part the same latter part but variable winds ends the day

This day commences with a fine Breeze from E East with clear weather ship upon distant tacks saw 5 sails middle and latter part the same ends the day
