heading N. W. & E. both middle and
latter part the same so ends the day.

winds. Ship heaving N. W. under all sail.
Middle and outer part the same. It ends this day.

This day commences with a strong N. E. trad wind. Ship heading N. E. and all sail. middle and latter part the same &c ends the day.

Sunday Feb. 23

This day commences with a strong trade wind from E. N. E. with clear weather. Ship heading West, under all sail. At sundown took in sail. Ship upon different tack. Made part the same. Made sail at sunrise. Ship heading S. E. Little part the same. To end this day.

Sunday Feb. 24.

This day commences with a strong breeze from E. N. E. with clear weather. Ship sailing West, under all sail. Two sail in sight. At sunrise shortened sail. Ship upon different tack. Made sail at sunrise. Ship heading N. by N. later part the same. So ends this day.
