

Remarks on Board Bark Mattapoisett
Tuesday Feb. 25. 1869

This day commences with a fine breeze from N.W. with clear weather. Ship heading W by N under all sail. At sundown took in sail. Ship pursuing different courses. At sunrise made sail ship heading South. Wind from E. N. E. At 7 A.M. saw Blackfish. Toward the boats and the Harboree struck and brought fish aboard. Men employed in mincing blubber. It ends this day.

Wednesday Feb. 26.

This day commences with a fine breeze from E. N. E. with clear weather. Ship heading South under all sail. Shortened sail at sundown. Ship heading different courses. Made sail at sunrise. Ship heading N. S. W. At about 7 A.M. saw Blackfish, toward the boats and the Harboree & Harboree struck and each brought a fish aboard. Men employed in mincing and boiling. It ends this day.

Thursday Feb. 27.

This day commences with a fine breeze from E. N. E. with clear weather. Ship heading S. by N. Men employed in boiling. At sundown took in sail. Ship on different tasks. Made sail at sunrise. Ship heading N. S. W. Latter part the same. It ends this day.

Friday Feb. 28. 1869

This day commences with a fine breeze from N. E. with clear weather. Ship heading S. W. by N. under all sail. Lighted land at the commencement of this day. At sundown the Island of Barbados 25 Miles distant. Middle part the ship laying off and on. Latter part running down along the Island. It ends this day.

Saturday Feb. 29.

This day commences with a fine breeze from East with clear weather. Came to anchor at Barbados at 2 P.M. in 13 fathoms of water. All hands employed in cleaning ship. Latter part the Harboree watch went ashore on Liberty. It ends this day.

Sunday March 1st.

This day commences with a fine East wind. Laying to an anchor. Harboree watch on shore. Middle part starboard watch came back aboard and Harboree watch went ashore. Latter part the same. It ends this day.

Monday March 2nd.

This day commences with a fine East wind. Laying to an anchor. Harboree watch ashore. Middle part Harboree watch came on board and Harboree watch went on Liberty. Latter part Men employed in painting ship. Latter part the same. It ends this day.

Tuesday March 3rd.
