Thursday April 8 1865

This day Commences with a fresh gale
from S.W. with squalls of rain Ship
under close reefed main top sail
Sailing S.E. East (saw 1 sail middle
part fresh gale latter part strong
Breeze from S.W. ship heading S.W.
se ends the day

Thursday April 9

This day commences with a light Breeze
from North Ship heading S.W. saw a
number of sails middle and latter
part variable winds ship upon distant
tacks so ends the day

Friday April 10

This day commences with fine Breeze
from East with clear weather ship
heading west by South at 1 P.M.
Saw 1 large Spinnaker Whale toward the
Boats but did not see him again
at 4 P.M. came on Board middle and
latter part light winds and calm so ends

Saturday April 11

commences with light variable winds and
clear weather ship upon distant tacks
middle and latter part the same so
ends the day

Sunday April 12 1865

This day commences with light variable
Breeze from West clear weather ship upon
distant tacks middle part the same
latter part strong Breeze from South
saw a number of sails so ends the day

Monday April 13

commences with a strong Breeze from
South with clear weather ship heading
E. East at 3 P.M. close tuck in sail for
the night middle part the same latter
part light winds so ends the day

Sat by ab 25.18.1

Tuesday April 14

This day commences with a calm (saw 1 sail
middle part light Breeze from East
latter strong Breeze ship heading South
so ends the day

Sat by ab 27.54
Ten by Com 28.11

Wednesday April 15

This day commences with a strong Breeze
from East with clear weather ship heading
N by E at sundown tuck sail middle
part the same latter part strong Breeze
from N.E. with thick weather so ends
the day
