Thursday April 16 1868

Commences with strong breeze from
SSE East with thick weather ship
heading E. by E saw 2 sails and a
steamer middle and latter part ship
upon dipnet takes so ends the day

This day commences with a strong breeze
from South with thick weather ship heading
dipnet courses middle and latter part the
same so ends the day

heading upon dipnets middle part the
same latter part light breeze so ends
the day

wind with clear weather ship heading
dipnets courses middle and latter part
the same saw 7 sails so ends the day

E by E middle part the same latter part
strong breeze so ends the day

This day commences with a strong breeze from
SSE East with thick weather ship heading
East at sun down took sail for the night.
Middle part the same. At 7^{am} saw whales. Lowered
the hook at 8 A. M. Latter part in chase of
whales. So ends this day.

Wednesday, April 22.

This day commences with a strong breeze
from S. S. E. with clear weather. Ship
upon different courses. Boats in chase of
whales. At 1 P. M. the Larboard boat struck
and brought the whale alongside at about 4 P. M.
Employed in cutting the whale's jaw. Middle
and latter part employed in cutting. So ends
this day.

Thursday, April 23.

This day commences with a light breeze from S. S. E.
with a smoky weather. Ship upon different courses.
1 sail in sight. Men employed in cutting. Finished
cutting at 4 P. M. and commenced boiling at 2 P. M.
Middle and latter part employed in boiling.
So ends this day.

N. W. with clear weather. Ship upon different courses.
