This day commences with a light variable Breeze
and clear weather ship upon different tacks
middle and latter part the same saw 2 sails
so ends the day

This day commences with a light Breeze from
South with clear weather ship heading South
at sun down tack in light sails for the
night middle part the same at day light
saw 3 sperm whales toward the boats and
the mast struck and had a foul line
and had to cut and lost the whale
so ends the day

This day commences with light Breeze
from South whales in sight at sundown
com on Board middle part Strong Breeze
latter part the same saw number of
sails so ends the day

this day.

with clear weather. Ship upon different tacks.
Several sail in sight. At 4 P.M. spoke
Lobster. P. A. Pine of Provincetown. 13 months
and 100 lbs from oil. Burns. Master. middle
latter part Strong Breeze so ends the day
