weather ship upon difreant tacks
1 sail in sight middle and latter part
the same so ends the day

tacks middle part the same latter part
Breeze from it ship heading South so
ends the day

from it with fine weather ship heading
difreant courses middle and latter part light
variable wind saw 2 sails so ends the day

difreant tacks middle and latter part
the same so ends the day

tacks middle and part the same
saw 1 sail so ends the day

heading it East under light sail
middle and latter part the same so ends
the day
