Sunday July 5 1865

This day commences with a fine Breeze from E by S with clear weather ship heading North middle and latter part the same same 5 sails so ends the day

This day commences with a fine Breeze from ESE with clear weather ship heading N at East. Several sail in sight. Middle and latter part the same. It ends this day.

This day commences with a light breeze from E. S. East, with clear weather. Ship upon different tacks. Under all sail. At 4 P. M. spoke Johnson. Barre Jones. Capt. Cornell 14 months out with 110 Bbls of oil. middle and latter part light variable winds so ends the day

Wednesday July 8

This day commences with a light variable Breeze with clear weather ship heading different courses 3 sails in sight middle and latter part the same so ends the day

This day commences with a fine Breeze from South with clear weather ship heading upon different tacks middle and latter part light variable winds with showers of rain so ends

This day commences with light variable winds with showers of rain ship steering different tacks middle and latter part the same same 2 sails so ends the day

Sunday July 12

This day commences with a fine Breeze from S W with clear weather ship heading SSE East. Several sail in sight. Middle and latter part a good breeze, ship heading different courses. It ends this day.

This day commences with a fine breeze from N. W. with clear weather. Ship upon different courses. At 5 P. M. spoke Chas. D. V. Richards of N. B. Capt. Russell. 13 months out with 90 Bbls of oil. middle and latter part the same so ends the day
