Monday June 14th

Begins with moderate gales from the South with Clear pleasant weather steering N.E. saw several whaling Schooners at sunset shot sail at 4 P.M. spoke the Schooner G. H. Cook of Portsmouth and found she had no oil latter part strong gales from the S.W. with smoky weather the Course E. By N two sail in sight

Tuesday June 15th

Begins with strong gales from the S.W. with smoky weather steering E. By N two sail in sight at sunset shot sail middle and latter part wind and weather the same

Wednesday June 16th

Begins with strong gales from the S.W. with smoky weather the Course E. By N the ship under single reef top sails at sunset close reef the fore top sail middle and latter part wind and weather the same

Thursday June 17th

Begins with fresh gales from the S.W. with light squalls the Course E. By N ship under reef top sails one sail in sight latter part moderate gales from the North with Clear weather ship under all sail heading E.N.E. at 11 a.m. passed an English Barque ^(British) the Steward still off duty sick

Friday June 18th

Begins with moderate gales from the N. with Clear pleasant weather ship under all sail heading heading E.N.E. at sunset shot light sails saw spin backs latter part moderate gales from the E.N.E. ship heading S.E. saw Blackfish

Saturday June 19th

Begins with light airs and calm saw Grampus at sunset shot the light sails latter part moderate gales from the S.W. with heavy weather steering E. By N

Sunday June 20th

Begins with moderate gales from the W. by N. with Cloudy weather the ship under all sail steering E. By N. at sunset shot light sail middle part and latter part fresh gales and light passing squalls

Monday June 21st

Begins with fresh gales from the West with passing Clouds steering East two sail in sight latter part moderate

Tuesday June 22nd

Begins with moderate gales from the S.W. with Clear pleasant weather the Course E. By N. saw sail in sight at 6 P.M. passed the Barque Fortune of New York middle and latter part wind and weather the same at 11 a.m. leaved for Blackfish without success
