Wednesday June 23rd

Begins with moderate gales from the south with clear pleasant weather ship heading E by S at 1 P.M. hoisted boats after chasing black fish at 3 P.M. lowered the Glas board boat for a spare at sunset stowed light sails middle and latter part wind and weather the same

Thursday June 24th

Begins with moderate gales from the south with clear pleasant weather steering E. S. E. at sunset stowed light sails middle and latter part wind and weather the same

Friday June 25th

Begins with light airs from the south with clear pleasant weather ship heading E. S. E. at 2 P.M. lowered for black fish did not strike at sunset stowed light sails middle and latter part wind and weather the same

Saturday June 26th

Begins with light airs from the south with clear pleasant weather steering E. S. E. on sail in sight middle and latter part moderate gales from the west & sail in sight

Lat 34.20 Long 56.36

Sunday June 27th

Begins with moderate gales from the west with clear weather steering E. S. E. on sail in sight latter part the same at 9 A.M. spoke the Bark Thomas Winslow Russell master two years out with 150 barrels also spoke the Brig Rosa Baker Stetson master two years out with 450 barrels gained a few minutes and with light passing gales steering E. S. E. three whales in sight

Monday June 28th

Begins with fresh gales from the N.W. with light passing squalls steering E. S. E. on sail in sight at sunset shortened sail and luffed by the wind heading W. S. W. latter part steering E. S. E.

Tuesday June 29th

Begins with fresh gales from the W. S. W. with clear weather steering E. S. E. at sunset shortened sail and luffed by the wind to the south latter part fresh gales and raining steering East

Lat 33.02 Long 52.01

Wednesday June 30

Begins with fresh gales from the N.W. with smoky weather steering E. under short sail at sunset shortened sail for the night and luffed by the wind heading N. N. E. latter part clear steering E. S. E.

Lat 32.03 Long 50.40

Thursday July 1st

Begins with fresh gales from the west with clear weather steering South at sunset shortened sail middle and latter part wind and weather the same

Lat 31.57 Long 50.01

Friday July 2nd

Begins with fresh gales from the N. S. W. with clear weather heading South at sunset shortened sail latter part steering off N. E.
