Begins with fresh gales from the North with clear weather ship heading East at sunset shortened sail latter part moderate gales from the N.N.E. with clear weather with a heavy rather by swell ship heading N.W.

Begins with moderate gales from the N.N.E. with clear weather ship heading N.W. at sunset shortened sail latter part the same saw no less
