

Remarks Cruising on the Western ground

Tuesday July 13th

Begins with moderate gales from the South with clear weather steering off N.W. at sunset shortened sail and luffed by the wind on sail in sight latter part wind and weather the same saw Blackfish and three sail

Wednesday July 14th

Lat 36.02 Long 44.21

Begins with light airs from the S. S. E. with clear weather ship heading S.W. at sunset shortened sail middle and latter part light airs and calm the weather emp. luffed steering down

Lat 35.30 Long 44.52

Thursday July 15th

Begins with a calm latter part fresh gales from the S.W. with hazy weather steering N.W. four sail in sight passed in hazy distance of an English ship

Lat 35.32 Long 45.37

Friday July 16th

Begins with fresh gales from the S.W. with hazy weather ship heading N.W. two sail in sight at sunset shortened sail latter part clearing a gale from the W. S. W. with rain squalls ship heading N.W. under short sail

Saturday July 17th

Begins with a gale from the west with passing rain squalls ship heading south under close reef main top sail latter part moderate breeze made all sail the wind N.W. ship heading N. S. W. the pumps attracted to

Sunday July 18th

Begins with fresh gales from the west with clear weather the ship under all sail steering E. S. E. at sunset shortened sail and luffed by the wind to the South Middle and latter part strong gales with smoky

Monday July 19th

Begins with strong gales from the west with smoky weather ship under reef top sails heading S. at sunset stowed the fore top sail latter part heading N. N. W.

Tuesday July 20th

Begins with strong gales from the west with smoky weather ship under short sail heading N. N. W. at sunset shortened sail middle and latter part wind and weather the same

Lat 36.35 Long 46.33

Wednesday July 21th

Begins with fresh gales from the W. S. W. with smoky weather ship under short sail heading N.W. middle part squally with thunders latter part moderate gales from the west with smoky weather ship heading S. S. W. one sail in sight

Lat 36.33 Long 46.26

Thursday July 22nd

Begins with fresh gales from the west with smoky weather ship heading S. S. W. at sunset shortened sail latter part moderate gales with clear weather saw grasshoppers
