

Remarks on Board the Barque Mattapoisett Cruising on the Western ground. Weston & Tripp, Masters 1869

Monday Aug 2^d

Begins with moderate gales from the South with Clear pleasant weather ship heading N. & W. at sunset short tunc sail latter part steering N. W. one sail in sight

Tuesday Aug 3^d

Begins with moderate gales from the S. & W. with Clear weather ship heading the westward at 5 P.M. spoke the M. M. Martin Schooner Fisher Master 8 months out Clear gamed till 9 P.M. latter part fresh gales from the west steering East one sail in sight

Lat 32.50 Long

Wednesday Aug 4th

Begins with fresh gales from the S. & W. with passing clouds steering East at sunset short tunc sail and luffed by the wind heading S. & E. Middle and latter part blowing strong from the S. & W. with passing squalls

Lat 33.28 Long 52.54

Thursday Aug 5th

Begins with fresh gales from the S. & W. with passing squalls ship under short sail heading S. & E. latter part Clear steering N. N. E. one sail

Lat 33.15 Long 51.26

Friday Aug 6th

Begins with fresh gales from the S. & W. with Clear weather steering N. N. E. at 5 P.M. spoke the Brig U. A. small Fisher Master with 250 Barrels of hump back got gamed a short time latter part moderate steering N. N. W. one sail in sight

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Saturday Aug 7th

Begins with moderate gales from the South with Clear pleasant weather steering N. & W. at sunset short tunc sail one sail in sight latter part Calm

Sunday Aug 8th

Begins with light airs and Calm ship heading N. & W. one sail in sight latter part light airs from the south

Lat 34.24 Long 51.11

Monday Aug 9th

Begins with moderate gales from the South with Clear pleasant weather ^{short} at sunset short tunc sail latter part fresh gales with light squalls

Lat 35.04 Long 51.50

Tuesday Aug 10th

Begins with fresh gales from the S. & W. with passing squalls ship heading N. & W. at 2 P.M. tacked ship and headed S. & E. at sunset short tunc sail latter part fresh gales from the west

Lat 34.45 Long 50.09

Wednesday Aug 11th

Begins with fresh gales from the N. & W. with squally weather steering East at sunset short tunc sail and luffed by the wind to the N. E. latter part moderate with Clear weather the fore topsail on deck for repairs

Lat Long

Thursday Aug 12th

Begins with light airs and Calm steering East sunset short tunc sail latter part fresh gales from the S. & W. with Clear weather steering E. & N. E. one sail in sight
