wind to the westward the latter part strong gales
with squally weather ship heading S E one sail on sight

Begins with strong gales from the S.W. with squally
weather ship under short sail heading S E latter
part the same steering E S E Lat Long

Friday Aug 27th

Begins with strong gales from the S.W. with Cloudy
weather the ship under short sail steering E S E saw
and shot a Killer to sink Middle and latter
part Moderate gales from the west with squally
weather the Course E S E Lat 36.08 Long 31.58

Saturday Aug 28th

Begins with Moderate gales from the N.W. with
squally weather the ship under short sail heading
E S E latter part strong gales

Sunday Aug 29th

Begins with fresh gales from the North with Clear
weather steering E S E at sunset short tunc sail
Middle and latter part wind and weather the same

with Clear weather steering E S E at sunset short
sail latter part steering East saw B

Begins with fresh gales from the South with
Cloudy weather ship under all sail at 12 M
saw and lowered for Blackfish got three
at 1.30 P M heaved the boat and steered
E N E at sunset short tunc sail and
luffed by the wind Middle and latter part
strong gales from the S S E with squally weather
the ship heading East

Wednesday September 1st

Begins with strong gales from the S S E with squally
weather ship under short sail heading East at
sunset now ship saw a Brack Middle and latter
part blowing gale from the S E with passing squalls
the ship lying too under Close reef main top sail
heading S S W the pumps attended to tiller no look

Thursday September 2nd

Begins with a gale from the S E with Clear
weather ship under Close reef main top sail heading
S S W latter part Moderate Boiled out the Black
fish

Lat 37.05 Long 26.40

Friday Sep 3rd

Begins with Moderate gales from the N E with passing squalls
ship heading S E at sunset short tunc sail Middle and latter
fresh gales with Clear weather the ship under
short sail
