

Remarks from St Marys south

Monday Sept 13th

Begins with moderate gales from the E & E with light passing 19 miles ship heading south and at in sight at sunset then tacked sail latter part Clear
Lat 31.41 Long 19.52

Tuesday Sept 14th

Begins with moderate gales from the East with Clear weather the ship under all sail heading S & E and sail in sight at sunset then tacked sail
middle and latter wind and weather the same one sail in sight
Lat 30.47 Long 19.29

Wednesday Sept 15th

Begins with fresh gales from the East with Clear weather ship heading S & E at sunset stowed light sails latter part strong gales at 8 a.m. passed a ship showing fresh Con Lar
Lat 29.47 Long 18.08

Thursday Sept 16th

Begins with strong gales from the East with Cloudy weather ship heading S & E at 5 P.M. saw the land supposed to be the island of Palma bearing south per Compass about fifty miles distant at sunset shortened sail middle and latter part wind and weather the same the ship heading on different tacks in and off shore

Friday Sept 17th

Begins with strong gales from the East with Cloudy weather the ship under reefed sails heading S & E at sunset shortened sail and headed off shore the island of Palma bearing south fifty two miles distant middle and latter part wind and weather the same

Saturday Sept 18th

Begins with strong gales from the East with Cloudy weather the ship heading on different tacks off the N.E. side of Palma at sunset shortened sail and were ship off shore at dark saw the house latter part moderate ship heading S & E

Sunday Sept 19th

Begins with moderate gales from the E.N.E. with Clear weather the ship heading S & E the island of Palma bearing S.W. twenty miles distant at sunset shortened sail and were ship latter part fresh gales from the E.N.E. with Clear weather ship heading S & E saw the island of Teneriffe bearing S & E at 10 a.m. tacked ship one sail in sight

Monday Sept 20th

Begins with fresh gales from the East with Clear weather ship heading N.N.E. at 2 P.M. passed a steamer at sunset shortened sail latter part heading S & E saw the island Palma and Teneriffe

Tuesday Sept 21st

Begins with fresh gales from the East with Clear weather the ship heading S & E at sunset tacked ship the island of Teneriffe bearing S & E ten miles distance middle and latter part heading on different tacks

Wednesday Sept 22nd

Begins with strong gales from the East with heavy weather the ship on different tacks on and off the island of Teneriffe at sunset shortened sail and headed off shore latter part more moderate the ship heading S & E By J.
