Sunday 21st Nov

Begins with fresh gales from the east with passing squalls the ship heading N.N.E at sunset shortened sail two sail in sight Middle and latter part Clear pleasant weather the ship heading N.N.E at 4 a.m. saw two whales Carasses

Monday Nov 22nd

Begins with fresh gales from the E with Clear weather the ship heading S.S.E at sunset shortened sail saw Black fish Cast a porpoise took a thimble squall from the S.E latter part light and variable with thimble squalls at 8 a.m. spoke the Brig industry of Barbadoes six months out with one hundred and twenty five barrels saw two whales steering N.N.W Lat Long

Tuesday Nov 23rd

Begins with light airs and Calm steering N.W three whales in sight at 3.30 P.M. lowered off for and all the at dark Cann on board and shortened sail latter part light airs and calm the ship heading N.W two sail in sight

Wednesday Nov 24th

Begins with light airs and Calm the ship heading W at sunset shortened sail two sail in sight latter part light airs from E the ship heading S. three sail in sight

Thursday Nov 25th

Begins with light airs from the East with Clear weather the ship heading South four sail in sight at sunset shortened sail latter part Calm and hot the main top sail on Deck for repairs three sail in sight

Begins with a Calm at 4 P.M. took a light Breeze from the East ship heading N.N.W at sunset shortened sail Middle and latter part fresh gales from the N with Clear weather ship heading West one sail in sight

Begins with Moderate gales from the North with Clear weather the ship heading S.W at 4 P.M. spoke the schooner Life Boat Newburg port Caton Master with 280 Barrels of oil gained till 6 P.M. shortened sail for the night latter part Calm one sail in sight

Sunday Nov 28th

Begins with light airs from the east with Clear weather the ship heading South at sunset shortened sail latter part Calm

Monday Nov 29th

Begins with a Calm Middle and latter part Calm

Tuesday Nov 30th

Begins with light airs from the East the ship heading S.S.E at sunset shortened sail one sail in sight latter part Moderate gales from the East ship heading S.S.E at 9 a.m. lowered one Boat for Black fish without success two sail in sight

Begins with squalls and variable with thimble the ship heading on distant track at sunset shortened sail three sail in sight Middle and latter part the same
