Begins with Moderate gales from the N.N.E. with smoky weather the Course W.S.W. at 5.30 P.M. toward all three Boat for Black fish got none at Dark Commenced and shortened sail latter part Clear the wind East the Course N.W.

Sunday Dec 5th

Latt 6.40 Long 18.41

Begins with Moderate gales from the East with Clear pleasant weather the Course N.W. at sunset shortened sail and luffed by the wind latter part variable with thunder squalls

Monday Dec 6th

Begins with thunder squalls and variable the wind varying all round the Compass at sunset shortened sail latter part Moderate gales from the East ship heading South

Begins with light airs squalls and variable with thunder the ship heading different tacks at sunset shortened sail latter part Moderate gales from the S.E. with Clear weather the ship heading S.S.W. the watch employed Coopering Broad and floor

Begins with Moderate gales with distant the wind east ship heading S.E. at 3 P.M. spoke and engaged with the G. H. Phillips schooner of Provincetown Taylor Master with 200 Barrels all sold at 6 P.M. shortened sail and shortened sail latter part Clear one sail in sight

Begins with light airs from the N.E. with Clear weather Steering N.N.W. one sail in sight at sunset shortened sail latter part the same
