Begins with light airs squalls and variables
at sunset shortened sail middle part heavy rain
latter part steering South Lat 6.34 Long 22.28

Monday Dec 27th

Begins with moderate gales from the N.E. with
smoky weather steering S.W. at sunset shortened
sail and luffed her by the wind latter part the
same as sail in sight Lat 6.12 Long 23.15

Tuesday Dec 28th

Begins with moderate gales from the East with smoky
weather the ship heading South at sunset shortened sail
middle part squally latter part Calm two sail in sight
Lat 5.47 Long 23.05

Wednesday Dec 29th

Begins with a Calm two sail in sight at sunset shortened
sail latter part light airs Calm and thunder squalls
two sail in sight Lat Long

Thursday Dec 30th

Begins with light airs Calm and thunder squalls two
sail in sight at sunset shortened sail middle and latter
part the same Lat 5.55 Long 22.43

Friday Dec 31st

Begins with a Calm latter part fresh gales from the
N.E. with Clear weather the ship heading N.W. two sail
in sight Lat 5.51 Long 22.57

Begins with fresh gales from the N.E. with Clear weather
ship heading N.W. at sunset shortened sail middle and
latter part rain and weather the same one sail in sight
Lat Long

Clear weather the ship heading North at 4 P.M. spoke
the schooner Olive B. Dyer of Provincetown Trip
Master with thirty Barrels of oil gained till eight

sail in sight Lat 6.27 Long 23.54

Monday Jan 3rd

Begins with fresh gales from the N.E. with Clear
weather the ship heading N.W. at sunset shortened
sail latter part wind and weather the same
Lat 7.09 Long 24.32

Tuesday Jan 4th

Begins with fresh gales from the East with Clear
weather steering S.W. at sunset shortened sail
and luffed by the wind S.E. middle and latter
part light airs with rain Lat Long

Wednesday Jan 5th

Begins with light airs and Calm with Cloudy
weather ship heading S.E. at sunset shortened sail
latter part fresh gales steering E & E
Lat 6.18 Long 23.37

Thursday Jan 6th

Begins with fresh gales from the N.E. with Clear
weather steering S.E. at sunset shortened sail
and luffed by the wind middle and latter part
light airs squalls variables and Calm
Lat Long

Friday Jan 7th

Begins with light airs from the N.E. with Cloudy
weather the ship heading on different tracks saw
one sail latter part Clear
