Tuesday May 3rd Lat 28.00 Long 78.28
Begins with moderate gales from the west with
Clear weather the ship heading S. S. W. at sunset
shortened sail latter part moderate gales
from the N. E. the ship heading N. W.

Wednesday May 4th Lat 28.31 Long 78.38
Begins with moderate gales from the N. E. with
Clear weather the ship heading N. W. at sunset
shortened sail middle part raining at 10 a. m.
cleared off the wind S. S. E. ship heading S. W.

Thursday May 5th Lat 28.33 Long 78.38
Begins with light airs from the S. S. W. with Clear
weather the ship heading west at sunset shortened
sail for the night latter part fresh gales from
the westward the ship heading S. S. E. Eight
sail in sight saw Blackfish

Friday May 6th Lat 28.19 Long 78.48
Begins with light airs and Calm the sail
in sight at sunset shortened sail middle and
latter part moderate gales from the S. W.
the ship heading S. S. E. saw one sail

Begins with moderate gales from the S. W.
with Clear pleasant weather the ship heading
N. N. W. at sunset shortened sail latter
part fresh gales from the S. W. the ship heading
S. S. E. Lat 28.27 Long 78.43

Begins with fresh gales from the S. S. W.
with Clear weather the ship heading west
at 4 P. M. took on a hundred 89 cell
from the west shortened sail as required
saw one sail middle and latter part
squally

Begins with fresh gales from the S. S. W. with
Clear weather the ship heading west one
sail in sight at sunset shortened sail and
tacked ship and headed S. E. latter part
moderate gales from the N. S. W. the ship heading S.

Tuesday May 10th Lat 28.16 Long 78.58
Begins with moderate gales from the west with
Clear pleasant weather the ship heading south
at sunset shortened sail and wore ship one sail in
sight latter part wind East ship heading south

Begins with fresh gales from the E. S. E. with
Clear weather the ship heading South one sail
in sight at sunset shortened sail and tacked
ship middle part heading S. E. latter
part the wind hauled west the ship
heading South
