

Nearby Coasting on the Western Ground
Wednesday Aug 17th

Begins with fresh gales from the N. W. with clear weather the ship heading N. W. at 1 P. M. saw a school of sperm whales going south to the S. W. toward all three boats without success at 5 P. M. hoisted the boats and headed N. W. By the wind one sail in sight at sunset shortened sail latter part strong gales the ship on different tracks under short sail one sail in sight Lat 35.29 Long 47.04

Thursday Aug 18th

Begins with strong gales from the S. W. with passing clouds the ship under short sail on different tracks one sail in sight at sunset furled the fore top sail Middle part the same latter part blowing strong with squalls Lat 35.43 Long 47.43

Friday Aug 19th

Begins with fresh gales from the North with cloudy weather the ship under short sail heading S. E. N. E. at sunset wore ship and headed W. By N. the pumps attended to 1 found little or no leak pumping out only what is put in to wash out the fore castle and cabin latter part calm had the fore cross on deck for repairs Lat Long

Saturday Aug 20th

Begins with a calm middle and latter part strong gales from the S. W. with squally rainy weather the ship under short sail on different tracks no sail in sight

Sunday Aug 21st

Begins with strong gales from the S. W. with thick squally weather the ship under short sail heading N. W. W. at 6 P. M. shortened sail and luffed best by the wind Middle and latter part wind and weather the same ship heading W. V. W.

Monday Aug 22nd

Begins with strong gales from the S. W. with clear weather the ship under short sail heading N. W. W. at 5 P. M. wore ship and headed S. E. Middle and latter part the same Lat 35.42 Long 47.47

Tuesday Aug 23rd

Begins with strong gales from the N. W. with clear weather the ship heading S. E. under short sail one sail in sight latter part strong N. E. Lat 35.33 Long 46.56

Wednesday Aug 24th

Begins with strong gales from the S. W. with clear weather the ship under short sail steering N. E. at 4 P. M. luffed N. W. By the wind at sunset furled the fore top sail latter part blowing strong with squalls with rain Lat Long

Thursday Aug 25th

Begins with strong gales from the S. W. with heavy squalls with rain the ship under reef main top sail fore top mast staysails and main spruce heading N. W. Middle part wind and weather the same latter part calm with a heavy swell with passing clouds and heavy weather
