Remarks on board Saturday May the 15th

Coment with a gail of wind from the westward
and raged with the winds in the fore part and
call the men down from aloft at four o'clock
Put the ship to the westward of New Bedford
Hinders master spoke as had it more moderate
thro the night with part moderate with
but a heavy swell running so ends this day

Remarks on board Sunday May the 16th

Coment with fair weather at five AM
lashed ship to the eastward and westward
at sundown took in sail saw two sails
in the distance thro the night saw no fresh
measur so ends this day Lat 31.20 Long 71.00

Remarks on board Monday May the 17th

Coment with a strong breeze from the southward
and raged with at sundown lashed a part
to the southward and eastward and fresh air
sail saw to sail, latter part fresh breeze and
raged with the winds to the westward so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday May the 18th

Coment with fresh breeze and raged a
strong breeze to the southward and
took in sail part moderate then in night
at day light moderate and lashed ship
to the westward latter part fresh breeze
so ends this day Lat 31.20 Long 75.45

Remarks on board Wednesday May the 19th

Coment with fresh breeze and fair with
saw gumpers and one sail at sundown took
in sail and lashed ship to the northward
blede a gail thro the night to the part blowing
and raining so ends

Remarks on board Thursday May the 20th

Coment with strong breeze from north west
and raged with heading south west by west by
the wind saw black fish with one tall 3 part
light breeze so ends cruising

Remarks on board Friday May the 21st

Coment with light breeze and good weather
heading to the westward at sundown took in
sail had moderate breeze thro the
night latter part fresh breeze
steering to the westward so ends
spoke the Schooner Union 31.00



Remarks on board Saturday May the 22nd

Coment with fresh breeze and fair
with saw breeches with colored 11 AM
at sundown took in sail and fore
ship to the southward and eastward
had fresh breeze thro the night latter part
strong breeze saw several sails appearing to the
eastward so ends this day. Lat 31.00

Remarks on board Sunday May the 23rd

Coment with strong breeze from south
west and raged and squally with at sundown
took in sail part moderate then heading south east
by south by the wind, middle and latter part
blowing a gail as common and raged
with so ends this day Lat 30.24 Long 76.16
