Coment with strong breezes from the eastward and aged wither at sundown took in sail and huffed to the wind to the southward and fresh breezes threw the night latter part strong breezes so ends at 21.50 Long 16.17

Remarks on board Friday June the 4th

Coment with strong breezes and aged and aged wither at sundown took in sail heading east by the wind had strong breezes and aged wither all this day so ended at 21.25 Long 15.00

Remarks on board Saturday June the 5th

Coment with strong breezes and aged and aged wither at sundown raining squalls of wind middle and latter part blowing a gail and ageing so ends at 21.00 Long 14.00

Remarks on board Sunday June the 6th

Coment with a gail from the southward aged and rainy wither at sundown took in sail heading to the southward and moderate some ship heading south west by the wind and aged latter part more moderate so ends at 21.00 Long 13.00

Remarks on board Monday June the 7th

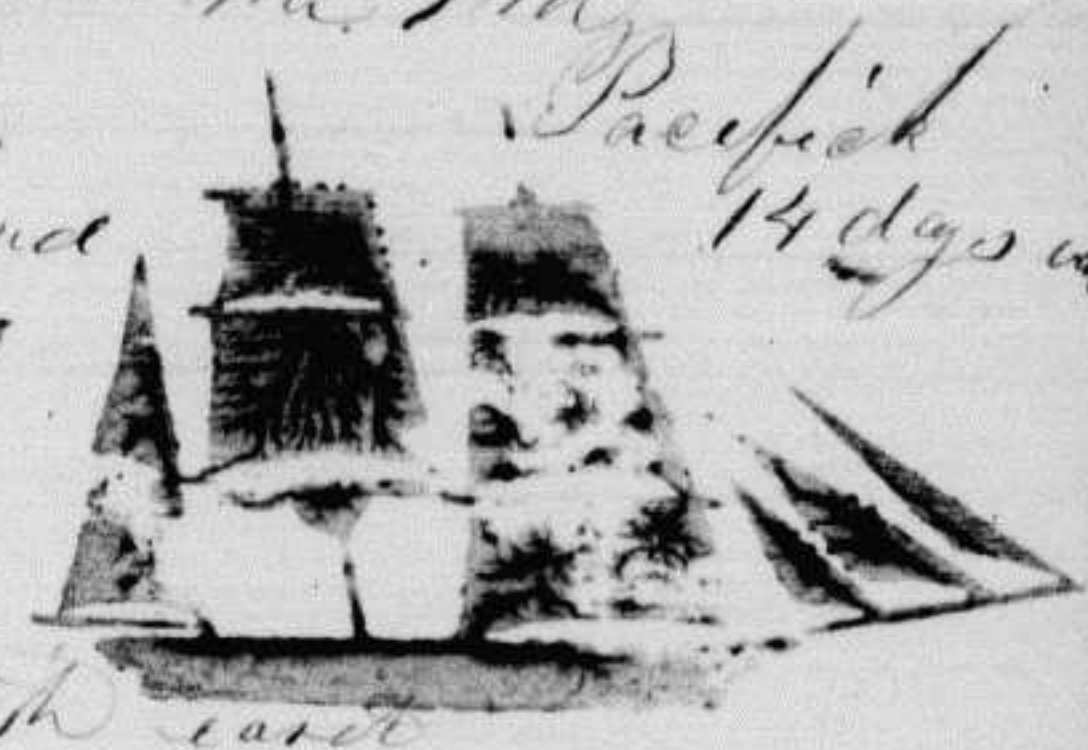
Coment with fresh breezes from the southward aged fair wither heading east by the wind and aged latter part strong breezes threw the night latter part rainy heading to the southward so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday June the 8th

Coment with fresh breezes and aged wither saw a sail at sundown took in sail heading south east by the wind middle and latter part strong breezes so ends at 21.00 Long 12.00

Remarks on board Wednesday June the 9th

Coment with strong breezes and aged wither spoke the bark Pacific of New Bedford Allen master at sundown took in the fore part of ship heading south east middle and latter part blowing a gail so ends



Remarks on board Thursday June the 10th

Coment with a gail from the eastward and aged wither ship heading south east saw the sails latter part had more moderate looked with to the northward saw the Pacific by the windward so ends this day at 21.45 Long 15.28

Remarks on board Friday June the 11th

Coment with fine breezes from the eastward and good wither at sundown took in sail middle and latter part light breezes saw the bark and a schooner so ends this day

Remarks on board Saturday June the 12th

Coment with light breezes from the westward and aged wither at sundown took in sail had it calm at daylight made all sail and aged north had light breezes from the southward so ends this day at 21.00 Long 14.00

Remarks on board Sunday June the 13th

Coment with light breezes from the southward and fine wither clear north part west saw four sails at sundown took in sail and huffed to the wind to the westward had fine breezes threw the night latter part good wither so ends

Remarks on board Monday June the 14th

Coment with good wither fine sails at sundown spoke the schooner E. Book of Providence at daylight left for the westward and aged east by north so ends this day
