Remarks on board Monday July the 17th

Coment with moderate gails from west south west and raged wither ship bearing to the southward at sundown took in the fore topsail had strong breezes thru the night at daylight set the fore topsail again and were ship to the north latter part strong breezes nothing in sight so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday July the 20th

Coment with strong breezes from southward and westward and raged wither at sundown took in the fore topsail had strong breezes thru the night at daylight set the fore topsail latter part strong breezes nothing in sight so ends lat 35.40 long 46.58

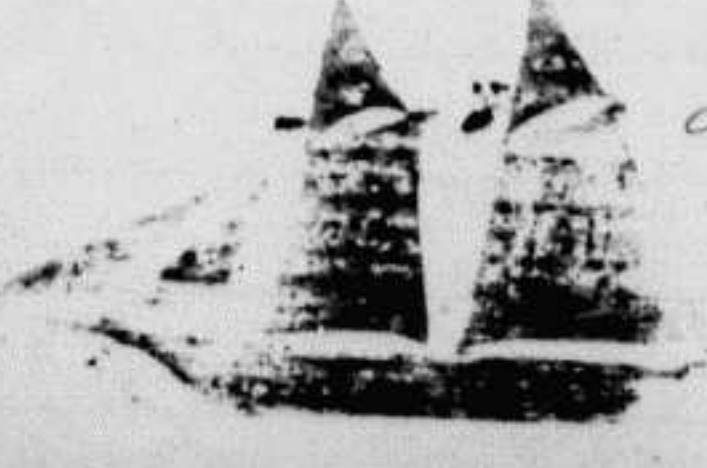
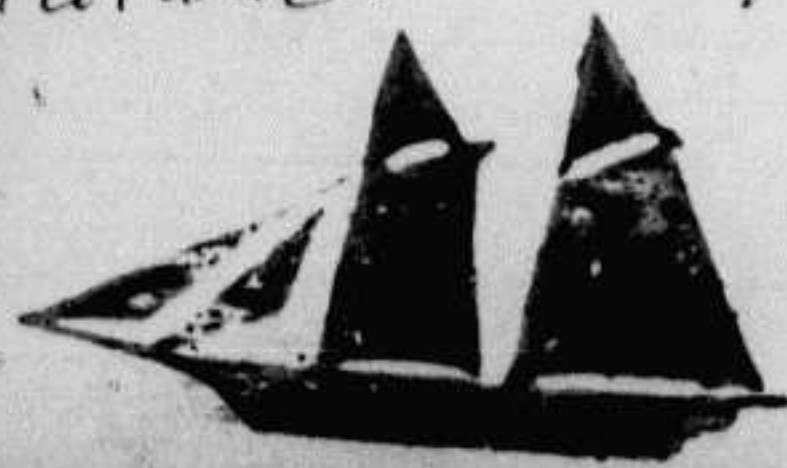
Remarks on board Wednesday July the 21st

Coment with strong breezes from west south west and raged wither ship heading north west on a sail steering to the eastward at sundown took in the fore topsail latter part of the night had it rany at six o'clock cleared off had it more moderate hoist the fore topsail and turned the reefs out of the topsails saw a sail steering to the eastward latter part fresh breezes heading south by west by the wind so ends this day latitude 36.40 long 46.20

Remarks on board Thursday July the 22nd

Coment with fresh breezes from the westward and fair wither the water at work having down the rigging at sundown took in the fore topsail made sail the main top strong breezes thru the night at daylight made sail and stood on to the southward latter part fresh breezes saw pinbacks so ends latitude 35.40 long 46.12

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Remarks on board Friday July the 23rd

Coment with fresh breezes from west north west and fair wither spoke to schooners at sundown caught the topsails had light breezes thru the night at daylight made sail and stood to the southward had a big clearing south east latter part light air so ends lat 35.22 long 46.58

Remarks on board Saturday July the 24th

Coment with light air from west and good wither at sundown took in sail had light air thru the night at six o'clock went to having down the mizzen latter part calm so ends

Remarks on board Sunday July the 25th

Coment with good wither but calm saw a sail to the westward of us had light air thru the night at daylight made sail and steered south west saw five more part vessels latter part light breezes so ends latitude 35.00 long 46.52

Remarks on board Monday July the 26th

Coment with light breezes from south east and good wither at sundown took in the big topsails at nine o'clock P.M. spoke the Burke Hadley of New Bedford 26 months out 200 blisters latter part of this day fresh breezes steering south west by south so ends lat 35.6 long 47.04



Remarks on board Tuesday July the 27th

Coment with strong breezes from southward and eastward and raged wither at sundown took in sail and left to the wind to the southward at daylight made sail had it moderate steady with west latter part fine breezes saw the early steering to the eastward so ends this day lat 33.00 long 47.38
