

Remarks on board Wednesday September the 15th

Coment with fresh breezes from the eastward and fair weather saw a sail clearing to the westward and a rough in sail had strong breezes then the night at daylight made sail the latter part strong breezes came on sail so ends lat 29.47 Long 18.03

Remarks on board Thursday September the 16th

Coment with strong breezes from the eastward and rugged weather saw land off the lee bow the island of Palma one of the Canary group at sundown took in sight ship heading south east by south at twelve o'clock were ship to the north at daylight were run to the southward and we were at the main sail and jib so ends off Palma

Remarks on board Friday September the 17th

Coment with strong breezes from the eastward and rugged weather at sundown took in sail and were ship to the northward had strong breezes then the night at daylight were down and set the jib and spanker and main sail the latter part strong breezes so ends off Palma

Remarks on board Saturday September the 18th

Coment with strong breezes from the eastward and rugged weather at sundown took in sail and were ship to the northward had strong breezes then the night at daylight made sail and were come to the southward the latter part strong breezes so ends off Palma

Remarks on board Sunday September the 19th

Coment with fresh breezes from the eastward and rugged weather at sundown took in sail and were ship to the north the latter part of the night were round again at daylight made sail the latter part strong breezes backed ship to the north so ends off Teneriffe

Off Canari islands

Remarks on board Monday September the 20th

Coment with strong breezes from the eastward and rugged weather saw a steamer clearing to the westward and another steamer to the south had strong breezes then the night at daylight backed ship to the southward broke out for provisions the latter part strong breezes so ends off Teneriffe

Remarks on board Tuesday September the 21st

Coment with strong breezes from the eastward and rugged weather at sundown backed ship to the northward strong breezes then the night at daylight backed to the south the latter part strong breezes and squally weather so ends off Teneriffe

Remarks on board Wednesday September the 22nd

Coment with strong breezes and rugged and squally weather backed ship to the northward at sundown took in sail had strong breezes then the night at daylight were ship to the southward and set the jib and spanker and main sail the latter part strong breezes so ends

Remarks on board Thursday September the 23rd

Coment with strong breezes from the eastward and rugged weather the patch at work washing off the ship the latter part of the night had it more moderate at daylight made sail and stood in shore the latter part light breezes so ends off Teneriffe

Remarks on board Friday September the 24th

Coment with light breezes from the eastward and fair weather backed ship off shore had light breezes then the night at daylight kept off for the north sail point off Teneriffe saw several small sails running under the land the latter part light breezes so ends off the north side point of the island
