Remarks on board Saturday September the 25th

Commut with light breezes from the northward and good weather. A sandown got down off the bow and took in sail being late to go in and made off and on through the night. Made again at daylight got up the shores and stood in to the house of Santa Cruse and at half past eleven we came to anchor so ends lying at Santa Cruse

Remarks on board Sunday September the 26th

Commut with good weather washed off the ship. There is six shallopman lying here had good weather all these twenty four hours on watch on shore so ends lying at Santa Cruse

Remarks on board Monday September the 27th

Commut with good weather at six o'clock I got redg and spoke out to take in water and got out weighing latter part good weather so ends lying at Santa Cruse

Remarks on board Tuesday September the 28th

Commut with good weather on watch on shore the other at work on board sent down to main topgallant yard and put on new foot ropes and lifts and weigh it up again latter part good weather so ends lying at Santa Cruse

Remarks on board Wednesday September the 29th

Commut with good weather got the water and pilates and cranes on board at daylight there up the anchor and stood out to sea and hauld a bass and a boat went on shore to look for the men that left the ship at the watch the boat came in board and we stood out to the eastward latter part fair weather so ends

Remarks on board Thursday September the 30th

Commut with fresh breezes from the north and fair weather at sundown took in sail and heave to the westward had light breezes there the night at daylight set all sail latter part light breezes so ends off haurffe

Remarks on board Friday October the 1st 33

Commut with light breezes from north east and good weather at sundown took in sail heaving to the eastward saw a Barge and a Schooner going in to Santa Cruse so ends at midnight there the night at daylight made sail and stood in to Santa Cruse and the boat went in shore latter part strong breezes so ends

Remarks on board Saturday October the 2nd

Commut with strong breezes from the north and rugged weather at two o'clock the top of cabin on board and left the ship off to the southward at sundown took in sail and left to the wind to the eastward had strong breezes there the night at daylight left off southward and left the boat off out of the life sail latter part strong breezes so ends

Remarks on board Sunday October the 3rd

Commut with strong breezes from north east and rugged weather saw the sails leaving to the southward had fresh breezes there the night at daylight set the main topgallant sail latter part fresh breezes so ends steering southward by west lat 25° 47' long 17° 50'

Remarks on board Monday October the 4th

Commut with fresh breezes from north east and fair weather at sundown took in the main topgallant sail had fresh breezes there the night at daylight set the topgallant sail again brigs but for floor so ends steering south west by west lat 24° 24' long 19° 01'

Remarks on board Tuesday October the 5th

Commut with fine breezes from north east and fair weather at sundown took in the topgallant sail and left southward west had fresh breezes there the night at daylight set the topgallant sail saw a few small blackfoll latter part fair weather so ends steering south south west lat 22° 24' long 18° 18'
