

Remarks on board Friday October the 29th 1869

Come in with light breezes from the eastward and go with the water at work rising up winging at sundown took in the light sails had it moderate thru the night at daylight got all sail latter part light breezes saw a schooner return of us so was staying south

Remarks on board Saturday October the 30th Long 20.05

Come in with light breezes and good weather saw blackfish at sundown took in sail had light breezes thru the night at daylight made sail at ten A.M. had it squally and rainy turn in the light sail, two sails in sight so ends

Remarks on board Sunday October the 31st

Come in with strong breezes from the westward and squally at ten P.M. took the light sail again saw blackfish at sundown took in sail ship heading south by the wind had it moderately thru the night at daylight come in squally latter part cleared up some for ends

Remarks on board Monday November the 1st Long 18.12

Come in with light breezes and fair weather saw great numbers of pinkbacks at sundown took in sail saw a sail to the west had it rainy thru the night at daylight cleared up some made sail and stood on to the southward and eastward so ends no boat

Remarks on board Tuesday November the 2nd

Come in with fresh breezes from south west and fresh weather at sundown took in sail had fresh breezes thru the night at daylight made sail and started ship to the westward at eleven o'clock picked Blackfish and looked for them but they was as wild as hawks so come in board so ends

Remarks on board Wednesday November the 3rd 1869

Come in with light breezes from south west and fair weather at sundown took in sail had fresh breezes thru the night at daylight made sail saw blackfish going quick latter part strong breezes heading south W by N so ends

Remarks on board Thursday November the 4th

Come in with strong breezes from north west and sized at sundown took in sail had fresh breezes thru the night at daylight made sail and stood on to the south latter part thick and rainy so ends no boat

Remarks on board Friday November the 5th

Come in with strong breezes from the westward and sized at sundown took in sail heading south had strong breezes thru the night at daylight let the reefs out of the top sail latter part fresh breezes and raining so ends

Remarks on board Saturday November the 6th

Come in with fresh breezes from south west and fresh and rainy weather saw blackfish at six P.M. caught the fish sails cleared off some at daylight made sail saw a ship steering to the southward and eastward latter part fresh breezes so ends

Lat 5.32 N Long 15.25 W

Remarks on board Sunday November the 7th

Come in with fresh breezes from south west and squally weather looked ship to the westward at sundown took in sail had fresh breezes thru the night at daylight made sail board for blackfish and the harbor and slurbud had got one ahead and the worst boat was took thru the ship and hasta there in so ends
