Remarks on board Monday November the 29th 1868

Coment with light air and good weather
at sundown took in sail middle and latter
part calm so ends Lat 6° 40' Long 181° 38'

Remarks on board Tuesday November the 30th

Coment with light air from the eastward and
good weather and a sail to the south at sundown
took in sail had light breezes then the night at
daylight made sail saw great quantities of blackfish
latter part raining so ends lat 6° 40' Long 181° 38'

Remarks on board Wednesday December the 1st

Coment with light breezes from the eastward and
rany within at two P.M. lited up some saw a small
ship at sundown took in sail heading south east middle
and latter part fine breezes so ends Lat 6° 40' Long 181° 38'

Remarks on board Thursday December the 2nd

Coment with fine breezes from the north and fair
within four the vessel boat for blackfish but could
not get part at sundown took in sail middle and
latter part calm so ends

Remarks on board Friday December the 3rd

Coment with good weather and light breezes
from north east saw a barkentine steaming to
the southward at sundown took in sail heading north
west then the night at daylight sail off west
soath west latter part light air so ends Lat 6° 42' Long 181° 38'

Remarks on board Saturday December the 4th

Coment with light breezes at five P.M. boat for blackfish
struck in and drawn from both at sundown took in sail
and kept to the wind middle and latter part light
breezes steering north west so ends Lat 6° 40' Long 181° 38'

Remarks on board Sunday December the 5th 1868 45-

Coment with light breezes from the eastward and fair
within at sundown took in sail and kept to the wind
had light breezes then the night latter part light
breezes so ends Lat 7° 12' Long 181° 38'

Remarks on board Monday December the 6th

Coment with squally weather wind from all quarters
at sundown took in sail had it raining had it squally
and rany through the night at daylight made
sail latter part light breezes saw a ship steering to
the north so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday December the 7th

Coment with squally and rany within at sundown
took in sail had it rany through the night
latter part light breezes heading to the south broke
out and covered the head and floor so ends Lat 6° 40' Long 181° 38'

Remarks on board Wednesday December the 8th

Coment with light breezes and thick weather
at four P.M. got rid of at sundown took in sail
had it raining most of the night latter part
fresh breezes and squally within heading to the
south so ends

Remarks on board Thursday December the 9th 1868

Coment with fresh breezes from the eastward
and squally weather at five P.M. the schooner Grace
Phillips spoke us at sundown took in sail
middle and latter part light breezes
so ends Lat 6° 28' Long 181° 34'



Remarks on board Friday December the 10th

Coment with light breezes from the eastward and
fair within steering west at sundown took in sail
had it moderate through the night at daylight
made sail latter part light breezes so ends Lat 6° 40' Long 181° 38'
