

Remarks on board Thursday December the 23rd 1869

Comeast with fine breezes from the eastward and good weather. A rock in the ocean saw blackfish at sundown took in sail had it rang through the night at daylight made sail latter part light breezes steering west

Remarks on board Friday December the 24th

Comeast with light breezes and thick weather at sundown took in sail had it rang and squally then the night at daylight made sail latter part blowing strong north the ship and left to the wind to sails in sight so ends

Remarks on board Saturday December the 25th

Comeast with moderate gale from the eastward and aged weather at sundown took in the forepart had it moderate then the night the ship Sarahola strike us latter part light breezes so ends Lat 6.57 Long 22.25

Remarks on board Sunday December the 26th



Comeast with light breezes and thick weather at sundown took in sail comeast sailing had it rang through the night at daylight cleared off made sail and steered to the southward so ends Lat 6.54

Remarks on board Monday December the 27th Long 22.22

Comeast with fine breezes and good weather steamed S.W. by W at sundown took in sail and left to the wind had strong breezes then the night at daylight left off with latter part fresh breezes so ends Lat 6.52

Remarks on board Tuesday December the 28th Long 22.13

Comeast with fresh breezes from the eastward and fair weather. A sand on left at the wind saw a sail steering to the south middle and latter part calm to sails in sight so ends Lat 5.47

Remarks on board Wednesday December the 29th

Comeast with good weather but calm at sundown took in sail middle and latter part calms and squalls to sails in sight so ends

Remarks on board Thursday December the 30th

Comeast with light breezes and squalls wind from all quarters at sundown took in sail had it rang then the night at daylight made sail latter part light breezes so ends Lat 5.55 Long 22.42

Remarks on board Friday December the 31st 1869

Comeast with light breezes and calms at sundown took in sail had it calm through the night at daylight made sail latter part fresh breezes too sails in sight so ends Lat 5.57 Long 22.57

Remarks on board Saturday January the 1st 1870

Comeast with fresh breezes from north east and fair weather. A sand on took in sail heading north east had strong breezes all these twenty four hours so ends Lat 5.59

Remarks on board Sunday January the 2nd Long 22.25

Comeast with strong breezes from the north east and aged weather at four P.M. the schooner Alie B. Gyre of the U.S. Capt. J. L. Smith came on board and stayed a while had strong breezes through latter part strong breezes. No sail in sight so ends



Remarks on board Monday January the 3rd Lat 6.24 Long 22.44

Comeast with strong breezes from north east and aged weather. A sand on took in sail heading N.W. by W middle and latter part strong breeze and aged weather heading north north west so ends

Lat 7.09 N Long 22.32
