

Remarks on board Tuesday January the 4th 1870

Comeast with strong breezes and raged wither at sundown took in sail and left to the wind headed S E latter part of the night had it raining latter part lighted up some so ends nothing in sight

Remarks on board Wednesday January the 5th

Comeast with fresh breezes heading to the southward middle and latter part strong breeze steering south west so ends

Remarks on board Thursday January the 6th Long 23.31

Comeast with strong breezes and raged wither at sundown left to the wind to the southward middle and latter part strong breeze thick wither so ends

Remarks on board Friday January the 7th

Comeast with strong breezes from the eastward and raged wither saw a ship steering to the southward had it moderate to the latter part of these breeze four hours so ends

Remarks on board Saturday January the 8th

Comeast with fresh breezes from the eastward and light squalls of rain steard of to the south middle and latter part blowing strong gails and rary wither ship heading to the northward so ends

Remarks on board Sunday January the 9th

Comeast with strong gails and raged and rary wither middle and latter part strong breeze so ends

Remarks on board Monday January the 10th Long 23.44

Comeast with strong breezes and raged saw blackfish at sundown saw ship to the southward middle and latter part fresh gails steering so with west so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday January the 11th 1870

Comeast with strong gails and thick and raged wither at sundown left to the wind to the northward had it rary all three twenty four hours saw a ship steering to the southward so ends


Remarks on board Wednesday January the 12th

Comeast with strong breezes and a gaily wither I saw one more ship to the southward middle and latter part fresh breeze haked ship to the north so ends

Remarks on board Thursday January the 13th

Comeast with fine breezes from the eastward and fair wither saw a ship steering south middle and latter part strong breezes so ends

Remarks on board Friday January the 14th

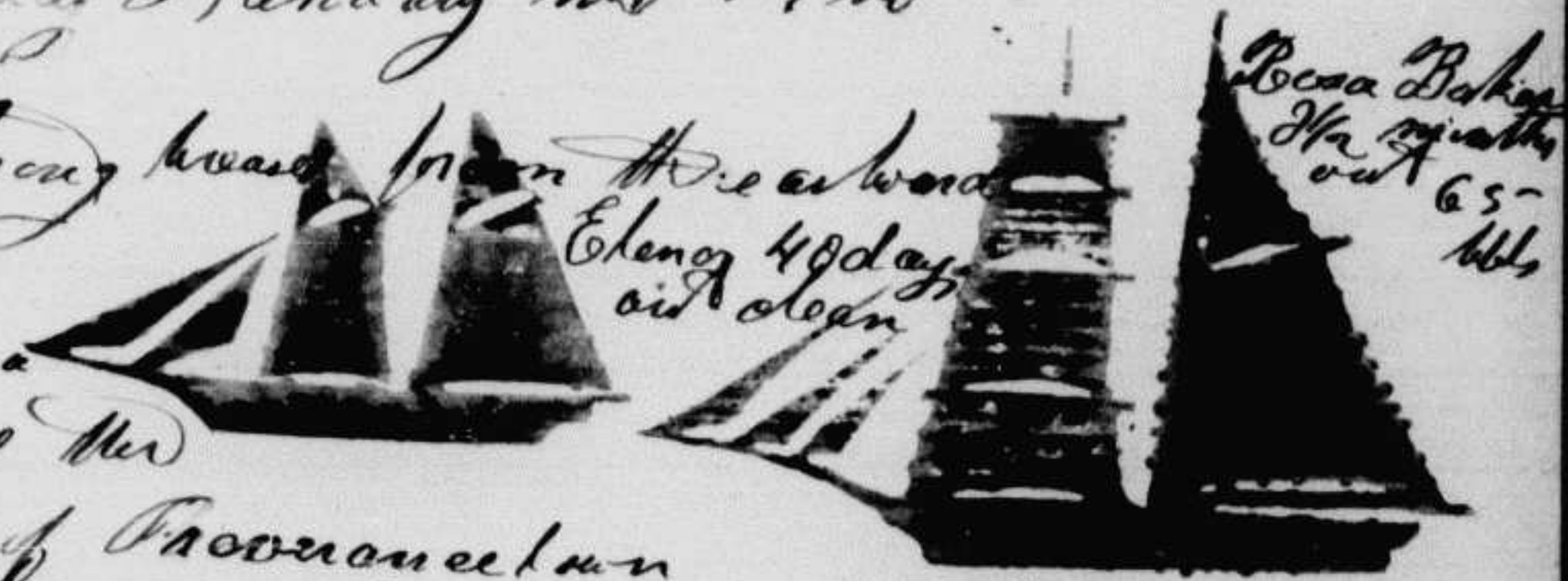
Comeast with strong breeze from the eastward and fair wither  saw a ship steering south middle and latter part strong breezes so ends

Remarks on board Saturday January the 15th

Comeast with fine breezes and good wither at four P.M. saw the Schooner eleven on ten miles ahead of us thought she was whaling middle and latter part fine breezes saw the schooner eating so ends

Remarks on board Sunday January the 16th

Comeast with fine breezes and good wither saw blackfish at sundown took in sail had it rary then the mid at daylight made sail had a light breeze broke the Schooner she had got a heavy barrel whale saw two merchant ships latter part light breezes so ends
