

Remarks on board Thursday February the 24th 1870

Commenced with fresh breezes and rages with a
sund can took in part left in a while and then
left off again at seven o'clock down to Bridge town
barbadoes and same to anchor there is a number of ships lying here
of all nations so ends this day lying at Barbadoes

Remarks on board Friday February the 25th 1870

Commenced with good weather washed of the ship and land
the iron work at daylight steady and commenced painting
at side latter part good weather so ends lying at Barbadoes

Remarks on board Saturday February the 26th

Commenced with good weather the starboard water in liberty
middle and latter part good weather four of the starboard
water have left and the higher of molasses in keels and
three barrels of sugar so ends lying at Barbadoes

Remarks on board Sunday February the 27th

Commenced with good weather the port water as here as liberty
middle and latter part good weather so ends lying at Barbadoes

Remarks on board Monday February the 28th

Commenced with good weather several small vessels
came in middle and latter part good weather so ends
lying at Barbadoes

Remarks on board Tuesday March the 1st

Commenced with good weather and fresh breezes at
four o'clock under way and stood out to sea steering
north north west at seven o'clock set half watches ship's six
men discharged one and four ran away at Barbadoes West Indies
had strong breezes through the night latter part strong
breezes saw the island of Cordoba and at Lucies
so ends steering for Demerara

Remarks on board Wednesday March the 2nd 1870

Commenced with fresh breezes and squally weather had fresh breezes
through the night at ten o'clock at 10 came to anchor at point
Barbadoes bay Demerara steady and broke out the water so ends

Remarks on board Thursday March the 3rd

Commenced with good weather sent afloat on shore and got off afloat
of water and took it in board at seven o'clock off shore had
good weather through the night the Schooner Allagha came
in twenty days from home latter part good weather got off another
raft of water so ends lying at Demerara

Remarks on board Friday March the 4th

Commenced with good weather got off afloat of water and
three boat loads of wood at sundown got stuck off all but
the wood had good weather through the night got off the rest
of the wood and got ready to get under way so ends lying
at Demerara

Remarks on board Saturday March the 5th

Commenced with fair weather got under way and steamed
to the northward and portward had a calm most of the
night latter part strong breezes so ends of St. Vincent

Remarks on board Sunday March the 6th

Commenced with strong breezes and squally weather
saw the island of near the windward had strong
breezes through the night at ten o'clock came to anchor at
St. Vincent latter part good weather so ends lying at
St. Vincent

Remarks on board Monday March the 7th

Commenced with strong breezes and squally weather
some of the men on shore at sundown the crew on
board had good weather through the night
latter part good weather got part of the gums on
board so ends lying at St. Vincent
