

Remarks on board Tuesday March the 8th 1870



Comment with strong breezes and squally weather got the remainder of the yams and potatoes on board and at six P.M. got under way and steered to the westward middle and latter part fresh breezes so ends off Santa Cruz steaming west

Remarks on board Wednesday March the 9th

Comment with fresh breezes and fair weather at sundown took in sail and at boats crew watched had fresh breezes through the night at daylight made sail to the port fine weather so ends of Port Rico

Remarks on board Thursday March the 10th

Comment with fine breezes and good weather saw several small vessels running along the land. At sundown took in sail and left to the wind to the southward middle and latter part good weather so ends steering to the westward off Port Rico saw Westport

Remarks on board Friday March the 11th

Comment with light breezes and good weather saw several sails. At sundown took in sail and at daylight through the night at daylight made sail took out for provisions latter part light breezes so ends off Cape Roa

Remarks on board Saturday March the 12th

Comment with light breezes and good weather saw several schooners and bugs steering through the channel passage at sundown took in sail had strong breezes through the night latter part strong breezes so ends off Cape Roa

Remarks on board Sunday March the 13th

Comment with strong breeze saw a humpback whale and latter part light breezes steering to the westward saw grasshoppers so ends

Remarks on board Monday March the 14th 1870

Comment with light breezes from the eastward and good weather at sundown took in the light sails saw St Domingo to the north middle and latter part good weather off Cape Beata

Remarks on board Tuesday March the 15th

Comment with fine breezes and good weather at three P.M. came to anchor at the island of Beata comment by the ship abouts were vent on shore and killed a wild hog, minkie and latter part good weather so ends lying at Beata

Remarks on board Wednesday March the 16th

Comment with good weather went on shore and got some mahogany for the ship painted minkie and latter part good weather so ends lying at Beata

Remarks on board Thursday March the 17th

Comment with fresh breezes and fair weather got under way and steered for Sam Bay at sundown took in sail had it moderate through the night at eight o'clock at night a sperm whale some six miles off at half past nine heard for three the harbor boat shook at high and the waist boat struck the same whale as he cut sperm turned him up so ends this day

Remarks on board Friday March the 18th

Comment with light breezes and good weather at one P.M. got the whale to the ship got redy and cut him in got through about sundown at six o'clock the harbor boat got to the ship had it calm latter part of the night got a light breeze and headed off shore at daylight got redy and started the work with fair fine weather and light breezes so ends off Sam Bay St Domingo
