

Remarks on board Saturday March the 19th 1870

Commenced with light breezes and good weather
at two o'clock I hoisted spinnaker sails six miles
off at three the land for three the first boat got past
the other boats shot them awhile and gave them
up. A half past four I took the whale to the ship
had fair weather through the night
at daylight commenced eating the whale
WB? M? D? more I got him in better part good
within six miles off San Bay St Domingo



Remarks on board Sunday March the 20th

Commenced with strong breezes commenced killing the whale
had squalls of rain through the night latter part
strong breezes so ends boating off St Domingo

Remarks on board Monday March the 21st

Commenced with strong breezes and fair weather I saw the
got through boiling middle and latter part strong breezes
saw a Schooner so ends off San Bay

Remarks on board Tuesday March the 22nd

Commenced with strong breezes and fair weather at sundown
took in sail middle and latter part strong breezes broke out
and stood down the oil so ends off St Domingo

Remarks on board Wednesday March the 23rd

Commenced with fresh breezes and fair weather saw a schooner
steering to the westward middle and latter part strong
breezes so ends off San Bay

Remarks on board Thursday March the 24th

Commenced with strong breezes and varied weather
middle and latter part much the same
steering to the westward off San Bay
so ends

Remarks on board Friday March the 25th 1870

Commenced with strong breezes and varied weather steering
to the westward at sundown reaft the topsails had fresh
breezes through the night latter part strong breezes so
ends off St Domingo

Remarks on board Saturday March the 26th

Commenced with strong breezes and fair weather at
sundown took in the topsails middle and latter part
calm one sail in sight so ends off St Domingo

Remarks on board Sunday March the 27th

Commenced with good weather and light air
at sundown took in the light sails had it calm
through the night latter part fine breezes saw
several sails so ends off Port au Prince bay St Domingo

Remarks on board Monday March the 28th

Commenced with fine breezes and good weather at
sundown took in sail middle and latter part
light breezes so ends off Port au Prince bay

Remarks on board Tuesday March the 29

Commenced with light breezes and good weather
saw several sails at sundown took in sail middle
and latter part light breezes so ends off St Domingo

Remarks on board Wednesday March the 30th

Commenced with fine breezes from north east
and good weather at sundown took in sail ship
heading N.W. by the wind middle fresh breezes
latter part light breezes saw Cuba to
the northward some forty miles off
so ends no lat
