Commenced with light air and good weather at sundown took in the light sails middle and latter part calm so ends

Remarks on board Friday April the 1st

~~LB~~ Commenced with light air and good weather saw to sails had light breezes through the night at nine A.M. raised a blackfish heard seen and the lashed boat struck him took him to this left latter part fair weather so ends off Cuba

Remarks on board Saturday April the 2nd

Commenced with fine breezes and good weather at sundown had a squall took in sail had light breezes through the night started the works and looked out the blackfish latter part fine breezes saw two sails so ends off Cuba

Remarks on board Sunday April the 3rd

Commenced with fair weather at three P.M. had a squall at sundown took in sail had fine breezes through the night latter part good weather off St. Jago de Cuba

Remarks on board Monday April the 4th

Commenced with fine breezes from the eastward and fair weather starting by the westward light breezes through the night latter part fine breezes saw to sails so ends off Cuba

Remarks on board Tuesday April the 5th

Commenced with fine breezes from the westward and good weather at sundown took in sail middle and latter part fine breezes and good weather saw a ship starting to the west so ends this day steering ~~west~~ off Cuba

Remarks on board Wednesday April the 6th 1810

Commenced with fine breezes from the eastward and good weather at sundown took in the light sails middle and latter part fine breezes so ends off Cuba

Remarks on board Thursday April the 7th

Commenced with fine breezes and good weather starting to the southward by the wind saw several sails middle and latter part light breezes so ends off Samarra

Remarks on board Friday April the 8th

Commenced with light breezes and good weather at sundown took in sail middle and latter part calm so ends off Samarra, Schooner Vernon

Remarks on board Saturday April the 9th

Commenced with good weather but calm to sea for blackfish but did not get past saw the schooner Vernon of St. Jago's latter part fine breezes starting by 11 so ends Said 18th 4th Long 79° 31' W

Remarks on board Sunday April the 10th

Commenced with fine breezes from the eastward and good weather at sundown took in the light sails middle and latter part strong breezes so ends off Grand Cayman

Remarks on board Monday April the 11th

Commenced with fine breezes and fair weather took a ship to sea ~~the~~ had it under way through the night latter part light breezes starting in for the land saw a sail to the north so ends off Grand Cayman
