

Remarks on board Tuesday April the 12th 1890

Commenced with light breezes and good weather
at four o'clock P.M. three boats came off from the
shore to trade at sand on the boats left for the
shore took in the light sail middle and latter
part fresh breezes steering to the west by the wind
so ends

Remarks on board Wednesday April the 13th

Commenced with fresh breezes from the northward
and fair weather at sundown took in the light sails
middle and latter part strong breezes steering to
the northward and westward so ends Lat 19.42
Long 82.57

Remarks on board Thursday April the 14th

Commenced with fresh breezes from the eastward and
fair weather middle and latter part strong breezes
steering north west so ends Lat 21.08
Long 84.30

Remarks on board Friday April the 15th

Commenced with strong breezes and aged weather
at sundown got down near Cape St. Antonio to
the shore P.M. part the light latter part blowing
strong steering to the northward saw several
sails so ends Lat 22.35 Long 85.19

Remarks on board Saturday April the 16th

Commenced with strong breezes and aged weather
middle and latter part were moderate
saw several sails so ends steering to
the northward and eastward

Lat 23.02
Long 84.55

Remarks on board Sunday April the 17th 1890

Commenced with light breezes and fair weather
at seven P.M. set half masted middle fine breezes
latter part blowing a gale heading to the eastward of the
wind saw Cuba to the leeward saw several sails so ends
Lat 23.05

Remarks on board Monday April the 18th Long 84.01

Commenced with strong gails from the northward
and aged weather wore ship to the westward middle
and latter part fresh breezes heading to the westward
so ends of the wind end of Cuba Lat 23.06

Remarks on board Tuesday April the 19th Long 84.02

Commenced with fine breezes and fair weather saw two
sails middle and latter part fresh breezes so ends off
the west end of Cuba Lat 23.20

Remarks on board Wednesday April the 20th Long 84.30

Commenced with strong breezes from north east and
fair weather saw a steamer steering to the northward and
westward saw several other sails middle and latter part
fine breezes steering east north east so ends
Lat 24.19

Remarks on board Thursday April the 21st Long 84.12

Commenced with light breezes from the southward
and fair weather saw the light house on sand key
middle moderate latter part strong breezes
so ends in Florida passage Lat 25.34
Long 79.40

Remarks on board Friday April the 22nd

Commenced with fresh breezes and fair weather
saw the steamer and several other sails middle and
latter part light breezes heading to the northward
and westward so ends Lat 26.42
Long 79.48
