

Remarks on board Wednesday May the 4th 1840

Comment with light breezes from the northward and good wither at sundown took in sail latter part of the night had it rainy at ten & Molasses off so ends cruising on the Bahamas Lat 28. 31 Long 78. 53

Remarks on board Thursday May the 5th

Comment with light breezes from the southward and good wither at sundown shortened sail middle and latter part squally saw several sails so ends Lat 28. 33 Long 78. 48

Remarks on board Friday May the 6th Lat 28. 28 Long 78. 48

Comment with light breezes and squally wither at sundown took in sail middle and latter part good wither saw a sail so ends Cruising Lat 28. 19 Long 78. 48

Remarks on board Saturday May the 7th Lat 28. 14 Long 78. 48

Comment with fresh breezes from S.W. and fair wither ship heading on different tack at sundown took in sail middle and latter part strong breezes so ends Lat 28. 14 Long 78. 48

Remarks on board Sunday May the 8th Lat 28. 14 Long 78. 48

Comment with strong breezes from southward at four P.M. took a heavy squall blow for about 8 and heavy at sundown thick and rainy middle part blowing a strong gale latter part more moderate so ends Lat 28. 27 Long 78. 43

Remarks on board Monday May the 9th

Comment with strong breezes and clear wither saw the sails at sundown took in sail middle and latter part strong breezes so ends cruising off Bahamas Lat 28. 14 Long 78. 04

Remarks on board Tuesday May the 10th 1840

Comment with fresh breezes from the northward and clear wither saw a sail to the windward at sundown shortened sail middle and latter part moderate so ends cruising on the Bahamas Lat 28. 16 Long 78. 58

Remarks on board Wednesday May the 11th

Comment with fine breezes and fair wither saw the sails steering to the northward at sundown took in sail middle and latter part blowing strong so ends Lat 28. 21 Long 78. 49

Remarks on board Thursday May the 12th

Comment with strong breezes and rugged wither at sundown took in sail middle and latter part moderate so ends Cruising on the Bahamas Lat 28. 10 Long 78. 38

Remarks on board Friday May the 13th

Comment with fine breezes and fair wither at sundown shortened sail latter part strong breezes steering south south east saw four sails so ends Lat 27. 55 Long 78. 37

Remarks on board Saturday May the 14th

Comment with fresh breezes from north west and fair wither at sundown took in the wind to the eastward middle and latter part strong breezes and squally wither saw the reef and kegs so ends Lat 27. 22 Long 78. 43

Remarks on board Sunday May the 15th

Comment with strong breezes from the northward and squally wither ship heading S.W. latter part squally and rainy nothing in sight so ends
