at sundown shortened sail middle part light air
latter part fresh breezes so ends heading north east
Lat 27.55

Remarks on board Tuesday May the 17th Long 78.55

Comment with fresh breezes from the northward
and fair weather at sundown took in sail middle
and latter part fresh breezes steering to the northward
so ends Lat 28.22

Remarks on board Wednesday May the 18th Long 77.50

Comment with fresh breezes and fair weather at
sundown shortened sail middle and latter part
fresh breezes so ends heading to the northward
Lat 29.16

Remarks on board Thursday May the 19th Long 77.59

Comment with fresh breezes from north east and
fair weather middle and latter part strong breezes
heading to the northward so ends Lat 29.11

Remarks on board Friday May the 20th Long 78.15

Comment with strong breezes from ENE and
saged weather saw the sails heading to the southward
at sundown shortened sail at 10 AM looked ship
to the southward latter part fresh breezes so ends
Lat 30.00

Remarks on board Saturday May the 21st Long 78.34

Comment with fresh breezes and fair weather
at sundown looked ship to the north and took
in sail middle and latter part fine
breezes heading north east so ends

Remarks on board Sunday May the 22nd 1840 78

Comment with light breezes from the eastward and
good weather saw a sail to windward middle and latter
part light breezes so ends Lat 30.12

Remarks on board Monday May the 23rd Long 78.25

Comment with light breezes from the eastward
and good weather at sundown took in sail
middle and latter part light breezes so ends Lat 30.08

Remarks on board Tuesday May the 24th Long 78.46

Comment with fine breezes from the eastward and
good weather at sundown took in the light sails
middle and latter part fine breezes saw a big schooner
Lat 31.08

Remarks on board Wednesday May the 25th Long 78.04

Comment with fine breezes from the eastward and
good weather at sundown took in sail ship heading N
Ely E middle and latter part fresh breezes saw a
schooner steering north north east so ends Lat 31.30

Remarks on board Thursday May the 26th Long 78.10

Comment with fresh breezes from the eastward
and fair weather saw a ship steering to the south west
at sundown looked ship to the south and took in sail
middle and latter part blowing a gale and rainy
so ends Lat 31.45

Remarks on board Friday May the 27th Long 78.58

Comment with a moderate gale and cloudy
set the fore topsail stand up some say the sails
at sundown the wind hauled south but ship steering
south east middle and latter part blowing a gale
so ends steering east south east
