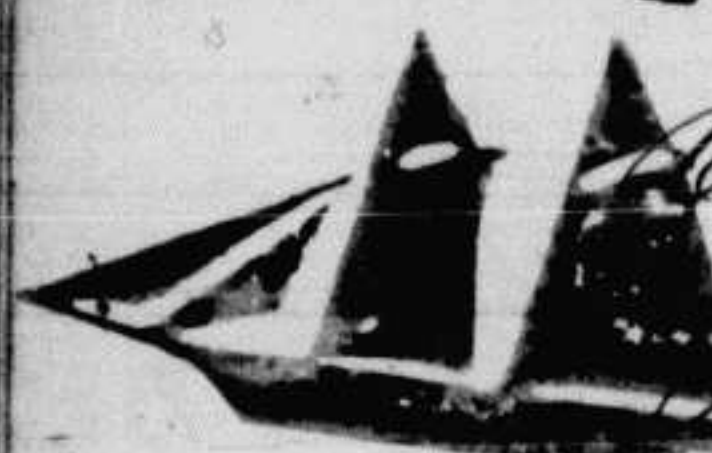

fair weather saw five Schooners at sundown took in
sail middle and latter part strong breezes so ends

saw several Schooners at sundown took in sail
middle and latter part strong breezes and
squally weather so ends

squally weather saw 10 sails at sundown took in
sail latter part calm so ends

Remarks on board Thursday June the 23rd

Comment with good weather but calm few whaling
Schooners in sight middle and latter part
squally and light airs so ends

Remarks on board Friday June the 24th

Comment with fine breezes and fair weather
at sundown took in sail saw 10 merchant ships
middle and latter part light breezes
steady with west saw a schooner steering
north west so ends this day

Comment with fine breezes from the eastward
and good weather at sundown took in sail for the
night had it calm through the night latter part
light breezes so ends

and good weather at sundown took in sail
had it calm middle and latter part
light breezes spoke the life boat so ends

and good weather saw grasshoppers at sundown
took in sail middle and latter part fresh
breezes so ends

and good weather saw killers of sandown took in
sail middle squally latter part cleared
off so ends

saw presakes to the windward at sundown took in
sail middle and latter part fresh breezes saw
small merchant ships so ends
