Commenced with fresh breezes from south west and raged within of five PM the big gale although spoke as middle and latter part squally so ends

Remarks on board Saturday July the 2nd

Commenced with strong breezes and thunder squalls steered to the eastward saw three sails at sundown took in sail and left the wind to the southward middle and latter part strong breezes so ends so ends

Remarks on board Sunday July the 3rd

Commenced with strong breezes and fair weather at five PM the shipmen & Belyre spoke at sundown took in sail middle and latter part strong breezes and squally weather saw one steamer and several sail so ends

Remarks on board Monday July the 4th

Commenced with strong breezes from south west and raged within of sundown took in sail and saw ship to the westward had strong breezes through the night and squally weather at daylight were ship latter part squally so ends

Commenced with strong breezes and raged and squally weather steering east at sundown took in sail middle and latter part more moderate steering east by north so ends

Remarks on board Wednesday July the 6th 1870

Commenced with fresh breezes from the southward and fair weather at sundown took in the light only had fresh breezes through the night at eight o'clock & raised a sperm whale & steamed to go for them they were going quick to the northward the dark boat struck a small one and fetched up to the ship so ends

Remarks on board Thursday July the 7th

Commenced with fresh breezes and squally weather at one o'clock PM took the whale to the ship at 10 PM the other boats came in board got red eyes cut the whale in got aboard away when dark had fresh breezes through the night at daylight started the works latter part strong breezes so ends

Remarks on board Friday July the 8th

Commenced with strong breezes from the south and raged within saw a sail to the windward at sundown took in sail had strong breezes at three & 4 PM got the whale holed at latter part strong breezes steering to the east so ends

Remarks on board Saturday July the 9th

Commenced with strong breezes and raged within at four PM took in the jib and spanker had it squally at nine PM saw the light at Hermata looked ship to the westward latter part strong breezes and squally weather so ends
