

Remarks on board Saturday July the 30th 1870

Comment with fine breezes and fair with
saw blackfish and a sail. Sandown took in
sail and left to the wind to the north had
light breezes through the night at daylight
made sail the harbor boat board for
blackfish but did not get any latter part light
breezes so ends

Remarks on board Sunday July the 31st Long 57. 00

Comment with light breezes and good with
saw a wreck some six miles to the south at
sandown took in sail middle and latter part
calm so ends

Remarks on board Monday August the 1st 1870

Comment with good wither but calm middle
and latter part light breezes so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday August the 2nd Long 50. 45

Comment with light breezes from south west
and fair wither at sandown took in sail ship heading
to the northward and returned middle and
latter part light breezes so ends

Remarks on board Wednesday August the 3rd

Comment with light breezes from the
southward and good wither the watch employed
sailing up zigzag at sandown took in sail
had it made through the night
at daylight made sail took in the
harbor boat and remanded it once put
it out again with light breezes
so ends steering north

Remarks on board Thursday August the 4th 1870

Comment with light breezes from the
south and good wither the watch employed
working in the night at sandown took in sail middle
and latter part fine breezes steered north east
saw a boat so ends

Remarks on board Friday August the 5th

Comment with fine breezes from the westward
and good wither were round and steered south
east at sandown took in sail and left to the
wind and latter part fine breezes
steering to the eastward so ends

Remarks on board Saturday August the 6th

Comment with fine breezes from the west and good
wither saw blackfish at sandown took in sail and
left to the wind to the south middle and latter
part strong breezes saw breaches so ends

Remarks on board Sunday August the 7th Long 48. 41

Comment with strong breezes from south west
and good wither saw a sail steering to the
eastward at sandown took in sail and
left to the wind the Bark Johnstone spoke us
from water out went on board and
saw papers middle and latter part
strong breezes steered to the
eastward saw a schooner
steering to the southward and eastward
so ends
