

86 Remarks on board Friday September the 16th 1850

Comment with a strong gale from north and a rugged weather at fore the ship headed up to the sea so hooked on and got the whole in a sand can see ship to the east had a more moderate latter part of the night breeze in strong at seven it started the works as a common building the whole latter part blowing strong and ragged the big Chollate of new york spoke us so on as

Remarks on board Saturday September the 17th

Comment with strong gale from the north and a rugged weather at sundown set by catches at to catch gale though blowing at daylight made calm latter part fine breeze so ends Lat 38 33 Long 40 55

Remarks on board Sunday September the 18th

Comment with fine breeze from north east and fair weather at sundown caught the lopsail middle light breeze at daylight made calm latter part calm so ends Lat 38 42 Long 40 28

Remarks on board Monday September the 19th

Comment with good weather light calm latter part light breeze steering east south east so ends Lat 38 51 Long 39 45

Remarks on board Tuesday September the 20th

Comment with fresh breeze and fair weather with the main, mizzen, and foremast at sundown took in sail saw a sail astern of us middle and latter part strong breeze steering south east by east saw the sails so ends Lat 38 45 Long 36 50

87 Remarks on board Wednesday September the 21st 1850

Comment with strong breeze and fair weather at sundown took in the jib and mainsail middle and latter part strong breeze steering east south east so ends Lat 38 51 Long 36 52

Remarks on board Thursday September the 22nd

Comment with strong gale and thick weather at sundown took in the fore lopsail and foremast leaving a strong gale left to the wind to the south middle and latter part strong gale so ends Lat 38 46 Long 33 08

Remarks on board Friday September the 23rd

Comment with a gale from the north and a rugged weather saw the barks heading N. the east about the main, mizzen, and foremast and saw ship to the east more moderate heavy swell sailing middle and latter part strong breeze saw the island of Solons so ends Lat 39 16 Long 31 46

Remarks on board Saturday September the 24th

Comment with strong breeze from the north and a rugged weather at sundown took in the jib and mainsail middle and latter part light breeze so ends off Liberia

Remarks on board Sunday September the 25th

Comment with light breeze and fair weather took aboard and the Captain went on shore at largest at sundown took in the mizzen middle and latter part fine breeze saw the sails and six sails on shore to get water so ends lying off Liberia
