

Remarks on board Monday September the 26th 1870

Comment with fine breezes from the westward and fair weather at three o'clock P.M. took the water on board and stowed it away at six the captain came on board and for a steered south west middle and latter part light breezes so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday September the 27th 1870

Comment with light breezes from the north and good weather rilled down one side of the margin rigging at sundown took in the light sails middle and latter part light breezes set down the mainsail and repaired it and bent it again so ends Lat 38° 09' Long 111° 11'

Remarks on board Wednesday September the 28th

Comment with fine breezes from the east and fair weather rilled down the other side of the margin rigging at sundown took in the light sails middle and latter part fine breezes steering south west by west so ends Lat 37° 28' Long 114° 51'

Remarks on board Thursday September the 29th

Comment with fine breezes from south east and fair weather rilling down the fore and main rigging at sundown took in the light sails middle and latter part fine breezes ship steering west south west by the wind nothing in sight so ends

Lat 36° 45' N

Long 82° 55' W

Remarks on board Friday September the 30th 1870

Comment with fine breezes from the south and fair weather saw the sails steering to the east at sundown took in the light sails middle and latter part strong breezes saw the sails steering to the east so ends

Remarks on board Saturday October the 1st 1870

Comment with strong breezes from south west and aged and squally weather at five o'clock P.M. reefed the topsails and took in the jib and mainsail and were left to the south at ten o'clock the wind backed to the north steered south west blowing strong the last strong gails and aged weather so ends

Remarks on board Sunday October the 2nd

Comment with strong gails from north east and aged weather at sundown took in the fore sail and left to the wind to the north saw three sails had strong breezes through the night at daylight left away west south west latter part strong breezes so ends Lat 34° 27' Long 116° 58'

Remarks on board Monday October the 3rd

Comment with strong breezes from the east and aged weather middle and latter part moderate to calm so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday October the 4th

Comment with fine breezes from south west at five o'clock raining took in sail weather fresh and hot had it squally through the night at daylight tide calm saw three sails latter part calm so ends Lat 33° 11' Long 88° 10'
