Weather fine light breeze from West, steering E by N. there was 3 sails in sight. took a linner at 9:15 Am and at which gave long 36° 24' 15" W last part fresh breeze from W²0

First part cloudy fresh breeze from W²0 steering E by N. last part cloudy on Port tack steering E by N. there was 3 sails in sight

Monday Aug 26th

First part squally close hauled on Port tack heading E by S. to day proached Mother's Cape at 6 Pm weather squally with rain wind N.E. At 7 1/2 o'clock raised whales going about E by N we were on the Starboard tack on the wind toward and 3 mats got fast turned him up and took him along side and commenced cutting in. the whales showed a good chance.

Tuesday Aug 27th

Weather Cloudy strong breeze from S.E. was cutting in at dark got off the head and on third the blubber and set the watches. At daylight caught all hands and commenced cutting in the remainder of our whale finished at 12 M. last part light breeze S.E.

Weather fine light breeze from S.E. by S on Starboard tack, heading E by N. started the by work and commenced by in cut at 9 Am picked up a 45 gal cask of Petroleum, one sail in sight.

Weather fine wind by N from S.E. by S heading E trying out. one sail in sight.

Friday Aug 30th

Pleasant weather light breeze from N.W. on Port tack spoke a Merchant Brig bound to England with copper from Brazil, finished trying out the whale making 95 lb.

Saturday Aug 31st

Long 33° 22' W.

First part cloudy with strong breeze from N.W. running on the wind on Port tack. At day light on starboard tack heading N.W. by W there was nothing in sight.

Sunday Sept. 1st

First part cloudy with strong breeze from NNE. on Port tack on the wind heading E by S. Last part Pleasant on Starboard tack steering N.E. by E with light breeze E.S.W.

Monday Sept 2nd

First part pleasant with light wind steering N.E. by E wind to S.E. At day light commenced cooping our oil there was one sail in sight.

Tuesday Sept 3rd

First part cloudy fresh breeze from S.E. steering N.E. by E. finished cooping oil at 2 Pm. At daylight raised the Island of Morris about 45 miles distant.

Fine weather fresh breeze from the SW running before the wind a boat came along side from the Island of Morris and done some traveling we took on by from the Island, and then shaped our course for Hazell's Cove. was 3 points forward of our beam at dark. This abeam about 112 miles distant. there was 3 sails in sight.
