good 180 bls to be shipped home in Bark Theodoris. of Fayall.
nothing else of account happened. in the first Part. Last part
Rainy weather some sun away from the ship. Mural Patch. S.W.

Sunday Sept 8th

Pleasant weather fresh breeze from westward. at 10 o'clock
taking in recruits (Potatoes &c) at 2 o'clock under way and stood out
of the harbor to cruise off on the Island and return Monday
for the Capt. Last part pleasant light breeze from South
by Starlight came out of Fayall with our Capt. on board
she ran down to us and became on board at 11.15 Am.

Changeable weather with Calms & rains was standing along
the shore of Pico within about 6 miles. At 7 Am
3rd mate went ashore with boat's crew to see his folks. Laying off and
on at Pico Pleasant weather

Tuesday Sept 10th

Pleasant weather light breeze from West off Pico at 7 P.M.
3rd Mate returned and brought of 4 extra men which wanted to
ship. Last part strong wind from NNW on Port tack under
short sail thick weather.

a chain one. there was one sail in sight.
