The weather squally strong breeze from East, steering S by E. hands employed in fitting the rigging there was 3 sail in sight.

Sunday Sept 22nd

Blackfish
Weather fine moderate breeze from E^{SE} steering S by E. there was 2 sail in sight. Looked for Blackfish and Starboard & Starboard Boat got on a piece took them along side and cut them in.

Monday Sept 23rd

Whale
Weather fine light air from east, steering S by E. Looked for Blackfish did not get fact, commenced trying out the Blackfish at daylight. At 11:20 raised school of small whales looked and Starboard boat got one.

Tuesday Sept 24th

Weather Cloudy strong breeze from East cut in the whale and at 6 o'clock raised whales lowered Starboard Boat went on and struck. Now Laurel. at 8 AM commenced trying out.

Weather rough but pleasant on Port tack heading S.E. looking Cape Looked for Blackfish but got none finished trying at 11 o'clock and the whale turned up 20 lbs.

J fell overboard at 1/2 past 4 o'clock. Did catch the slide board on the starboard quarter, broke out water.

Thursday Sept 26th

The weather pleasant strong breeze and ruffia. Looked out ship cash. for the men, steering S.W. nothing of moment occurred.

Weather fine strong breeze from N.E. steering S.W. set up maintop gallant backstay and martingal guins. Last part clear moderate breeze from N.E. steering S.W. by W.

First part fine weather wind N.E. steering S.W. by W. 2 loads down our oil 20 lb Spent 2 lb Blackfish. made a line tub nothing else of account happened.
